

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

Scope:

This work proposes hiring a contractor to provide equipment and training for a study to determine the best adsorption material to remove arsenic from the Nespelem Agency's Community Water System by providing all necessary equipment, installation, monitoring and maintaining equipment throughout the study, removing the equipment, and disposing of any waste once the study is concluded.

Performance Time:

Contractor shall begin work as described in the Summary of Work within 5 days of Notice To Proceed (NTP). It is expected that the Test Assembly will be onsite and ready to operate within 30-days of the NTP. Upon completion of the study, the Contractor will be notified and the Test Assembly must be removed within 30-days of that notice. This is expected to be within 240 days of the NTP.

Payment:

Payment will be based on completed and accepted work performed in accordance with the work described in the Summary of Work. Progress payments may be made during the study.
